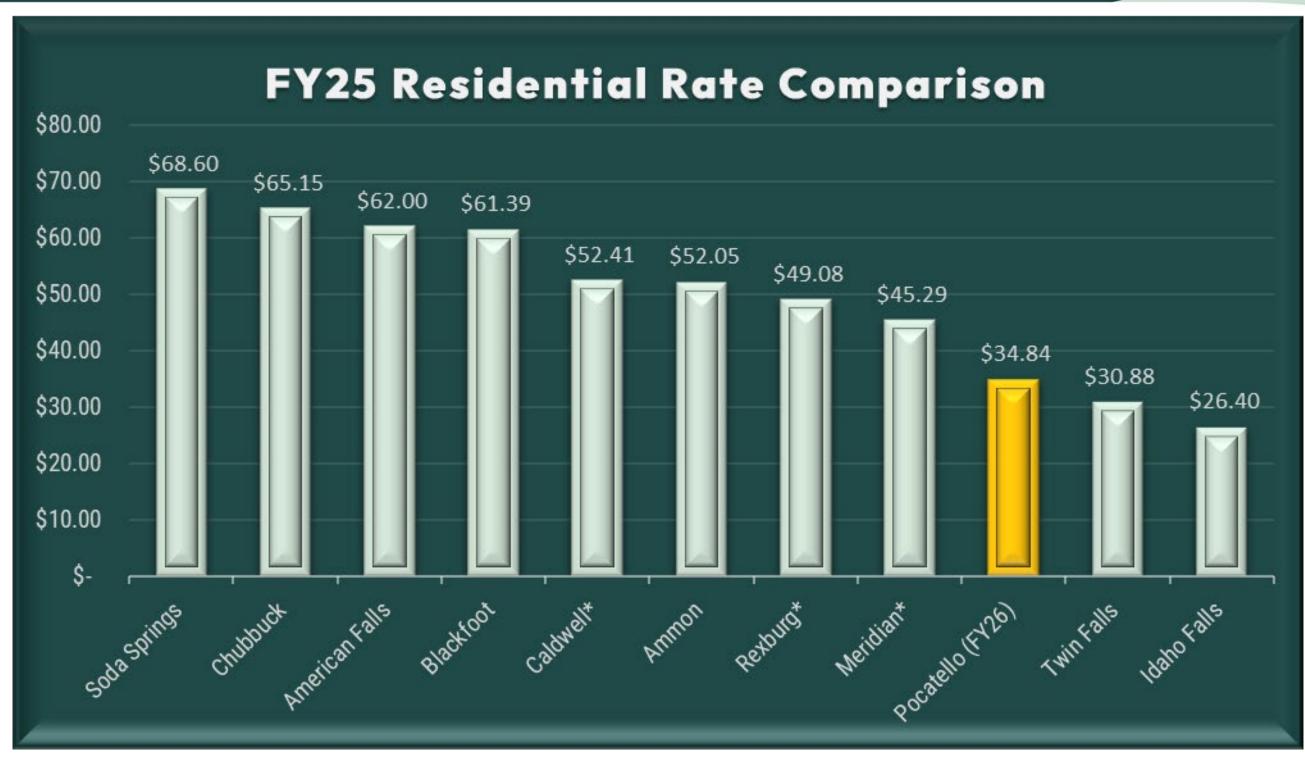

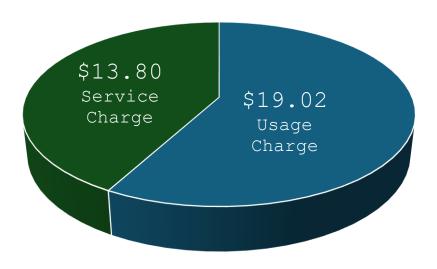

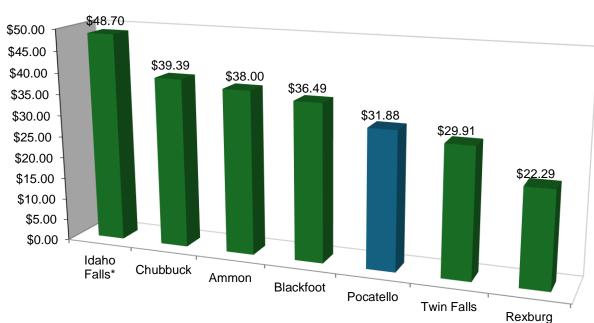
Proposed Fee Increases

• Idaho Falls charges a flat rate of \$31.60 + \$16.85 (irrigation) + \$0.25 (DEQ fee) = \$48.70/mo

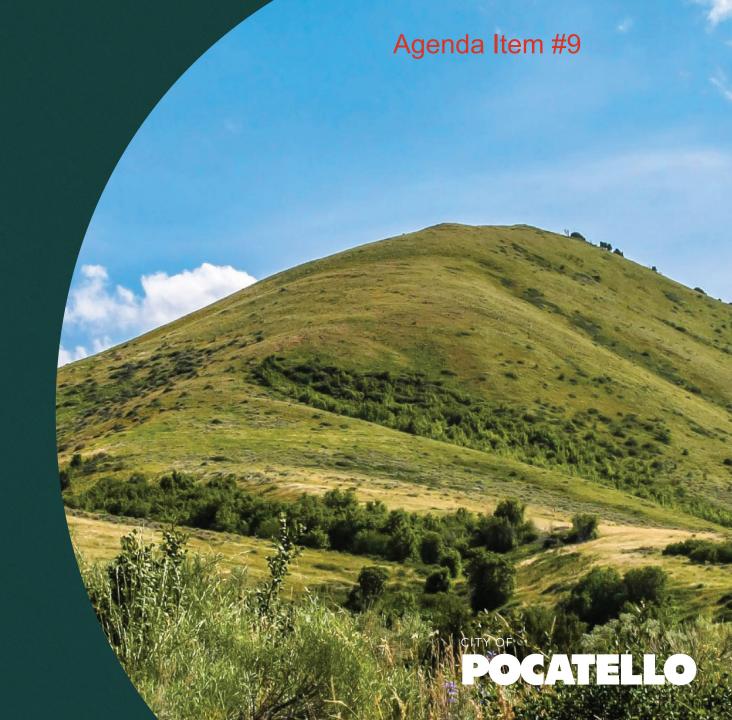

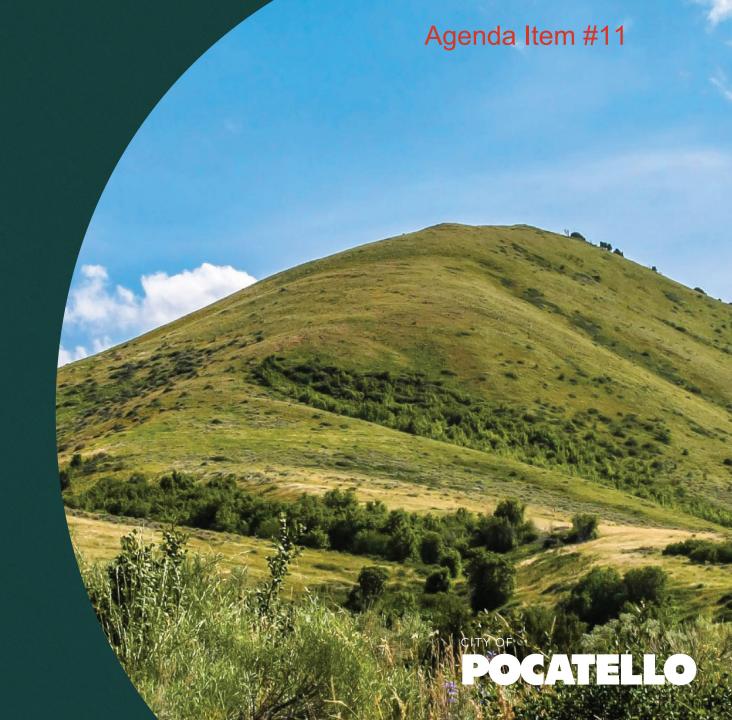
