



#### Global Economy



- -Global GDP growth projected around 3.2%
- -Inflation easing in advanced economies
- -Geopolitical tensions and energy costs remain key risks
- -US National Debt by 2030 --\$45 Trillion to \$50 Trillion (Forbes)
- -Interest Payment by 2033–Exceed \$1.4 Trillion (Congressional Budget Office)
- -US Debt rating no longer AAA



## USA Economy Projection (2025)



- GDP growth expected at 1.7% (Fed projection)
- Core PCE Inflation forecasted at 2.8%
- Unemployment rate projected at 4.4%
- Federal Reserve signals possible rate cuts in late 2025
- Cost to repair Crumbling Infiltrator \$9.1 Trillion (America Society of Civil Engineers)
- VIX at 36 (Market Volatility Index) 20-25 Normal, Over 30 Fear & volatility, and 12-15 Calm market








## Idaho Economy (April 2025)



- **Unemployment: 3.7% (Feb 2025)**
- Labor force participation rising
- Tech & healthcare sector growth (e.g., Micron in Boise)
- State revenue forecasts strong through 2029

- Job postings up 6% in February 2025 (YoY growth)
- Healthcare and manufacturing key sectors
- Idaho State University influences labor & housing
- Affordable housing and moderate living costs
