The fire department is requesting Council approval to declare a 2000 Pierce Dash 100' Tower as surplus and sell it to the Central Fire District. The sale of this apparatus has been planned since 2022, when the new aerial order was placed. We were able to find a neighboring department that needs an aerial apparatus. Central Fire District covers the area in Jefferson County, ID area. This transaction improves fire services in East Idaho and represents good value for the Pocatello Fire Department and the Central Fire District. We have mutual aid agreements with Central Fire, so the apparatus will still be available in the region for a large event. The agreed upon price for this apparatus is \$85,000.
