



ROAD CLOSURES & TRAFFIC REPORTS

Beginning the week of June 10, 2024

➔ STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT **SWEEPING**

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is completed, crews will move to their regular summer sweeping schedule.

Regular sweeping schedule:

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

CATCH BASIN REPLACEMENT – BANNOCK HIGHWAY

Beginning Monday, June 10, 2024, for approx. 2 to 3 weeks, a private contractor will be working on the catch basin replacement and the construction of curb and gutter on S. Main Street/Bannock Hwy. The work will be around the 1100 Block of S. Main Street. A crew will work between the hours of 8:00 AM to approximately 5:00 PM. While work is being performed, there will be intermittent lane closures. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

➔ WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER LINE INSTALLATION – GARRETT WY, MADISON AVE, COLORADO AVE. & MAPLE ST.

Beginning Thursday, March 21, 2024, for approximately 8 weeks, crews from Water Department will be replacing the water main line on Garrett Way, Madison Avenue, Colorado Avenue, and Maple Street. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during working hours. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.

ANNUAL HYDRANT FLUSHING PROGRAM

Water Department will be conducting their annual hydrant flushing program beginning Monday, May 20, 2024 and will take approximately three weeks to complete. If you see a crew flushing a hydrant on your street, we recommend you avoid running tap water or using the washing machine or dishwasher until flushing is completed. If you see hydrant-flushing crews working, please drive carefully and treat them like any other road construction crew.

➔ WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

➔ IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Beginning Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. as part of the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. This portion of Chubbuck Rd. will remain closed until Fall 2024 for roadway and bridge construction activities. A detour directing traffic around the closure via New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway is in operation. RELOCATION OF A NATURAL GAS LINE

Beginning Monday, June 10 through Jun 14, 2024, Intermountain Gas will be relocating a natural gas service line for 805 N. Arthur Ave. There will be temporary road closures on 400 Block of W. Sublette St. from N. Garfield Ave. to N. Arthur Ave. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

MAINTENANCE OF A NATURAL GAS LINE

Beginning Saturday, June 15 through Jun 28, 2024, Intermountain Gas will be performing a required maintenance of natural gas service line. There will be temporary road closures on 700 Block of E. Wyeth St. from N. 6th Ave. to N. 7th Ave. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

CANNON BUILDERS – CENTER STREET UNDERPASS

The Center Street underpass is scheduled to undergo structural work on the ingress/egress retaining walls from April to late October 2024. As a result, the underpass will be closed during this period. We request you to kindly plan your travel and use alternate routes while the construction is in progress. The contractor will make efforts to keep a pedestrian route open. Please note that it will be an active construction zone, so exercise caution while entering the area.
