➔ STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

MICRO SEAL

Valley Slurry Seal will begin micro-sealing the streets listed in the schedule below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. No parking will be allowed on these streets from 7 AM – 6 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

- E Poplar St (*Eastridge Dr to Jefferson Ave*)
- Willard Ave (*E Pine St to E Oak St*)

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will patch potholes and curb lines citywide, possibly causing lane closures and delays. Motorists should proceed with caution.

MILLING AND PAVING

The Street Operations crew will be paving the following locations from 7 AM until completed. The roads will be closed while work is being performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

- Monday, August 5, 2024: **Franklin Ave.** (*from E. Elm St. to Spruce St.*)
- Tuesday, August 6, 2024: **Sego St.** and **Primrose Ave.**
- Wednesday, August 7 & Thursday, August 8, 2024: **E. Humbolt St.** (*from S. 2nd Ave to S. 5th Ave.*)

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Beginning Monday, June 24, 2024, Traffic Operations will repaint crosswalks and arrows across the City, starting at schools. Lane closures will occur intermittently. Drivers should follow traffic control, avoid fresh paint, and expect delays during the painting season.

➔ **WATER DEPARTMENT**

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – WINGATE DR., TURACO AVE., FLAMINGO PL. AND FLAMINGO DR.

Starting July 1, 2024, the Water Department will replace water mainlines on Wingate Dr., Turaco Ave., Flamingo Pl., and Flamingo Dr. Work hours are 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Thursday. Street closures and restricted parking will be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution.

➔ **WATER POLLUTION CONTROL**

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

➔ **IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. beginning August 10, 2022, until Fall 2024 for construction related to the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. CENTER STREET UNDERPASS

The Center Street underpass project has been paused. It will reopen late this summer until work can resume. The road will be repaved before reopening. We advise motorists to plan ahead and utilize alternative routes. There is a pedestrian pathway, please exercise caution when entering.

HAWTHORNE RD. AND W. QUINN RD.

Contractors and crew members are working on the installation of the traffic signal poles at the intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W Quinn Rd., leading to road closures. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

MICHELS PACIFIC ENERGY – COUNTRY CLUB DR.

Starting July 8, 2024, crew members will upgrade the Pocatello 13 distribution feeder to current IPC standards until August 16, 2024, from 8AM to 4PM. This involves replacing components on overhead distribution poles, leading to intermittent lane closures. Motorists should exercise caution and anticipate delays in the area.

D-CO CONCRETE – S 5TH AVE.

From July 8 to August 8, 2024, ADA ramps will be installed at the S. 5th Ave. and Clark St. intersection, leading to intermittent lane closures. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

PRO BUILDERS – HAWTHORNE RD. AND JENSEN ST.

Starting July 25, 2024, for approximately 6 weeks, crew members will be installing sidewalk, curb, and gutter at Hawthorne Rd. and Jensen St. causing road closures. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

CM COMPANY, INC. – N 6TH AVE.

From July 29 to November 30, 2024, CM Company, Inc. will be working on the construction of roadway and sidewalk improvement on N 6th Ave. There will be road closures between E. Clark St and E. Center. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

ENGINEERED STRUCTURES, INC. (ESI) – MARTIN LUTHER KING JR WAY.

From July 30 to August 20, 2024, ESI will bore power communication lines from ISU campus to Eli Oboler Library. There will be intermittent lane closure on Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

The event runs from 2-10 PM, with road closures in the 100 block of S Garfield Ave. Motorists please be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

NEON STREET FEST

Historic Downtown Pocatello is hosting "Neon Street Fest" on August 3, 2024, from 1-11 PM. The event is located at the 200 and part of 300 block of E. Center Street. This area will be closed during the above-referenced times. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
