STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will patch potholes and curb lines citywide, possibly causing lane closures and delays. Motorists should proceed with caution.

MILLING AND PAVING

The Street Operations crew will be paving the following locations from 7 AM until completed. The roads will be closed while work is being performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

- Monday, August 12 & Tuesday, August 13, 2024: E. Alameda Rd. (from Jefferson Ave. to Monte Vista Dr.)
- Wednesday, August 14 & Thursday, August 15, 2024: Pocatello Creek Rd. (from Bench Rd. to Booth Dr.) There will be intermittent lane closures on Pocatello Creek Rd.

PAVEMENT MARKING

Traffic Operations Department is repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings across the City, starting at schools. Lane closures will occur intermittently. Drivers should follow traffic control, avoid fresh paint, and expect delays during the painting season.

WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – WINGATE DR., TURACO AVE., FLAMINGO PL. AND FLAMINGO DR.

Starting July 1, 2024, the Water Department will replace water mainlines on Wingate Dr., Turaco Ave., Flamingo Pl., and Flamingo Dr. Work hours are 6:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Street closures and restricted parking will be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution.

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. beginning August 10, 2022, until Fall 2024 for construction related to the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. CONTRACTORS

CENTER STREET UNDERPASS

The Center Street underpass project has been paused. It will reopen late this summer until work can resume. The road will be repaved before reopening. We advise motorists to plan ahead and utilize alternative routes. There is a pedestrian pathway, please exercise caution when entering.

HAWTHORNE RD. AND W. QUINN RD.

Contractors and crew members are working on the installation of the traffic signal poles at the intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W Quinn Rd., leading to road closures. Please use alternate routes for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

MICHELS PACIFIC ENERGY – COUNTRY CLUB DR.

From July 8 to August 16, 2024, from 8 AM to 4 PM, crew members will upgrade the Pocatello 13 distribution feeder to current IPC standards. This involves replacing components on overhead distribution poles, leading to intermittent lane closures. Motorists should exercise caution and anticipate delays in the area.

PRO BUILDERS - HAWTHORNE RD. AND JENSEN ST.

From August 12 to August 21, 2024, or until work is completed, crew members will be installing sidewalk, curb, and gutter at Hawthorne Rd. and Jensen St. causing road closures. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

CM COMPANY, INC. – N 6TH AVE.

From July 29 to November 30, 2024, CM Company, Inc. will be working on the construction of roadway and sidewalk improvement on N 6th Ave. There will be road closures between E. Clark St and E. Center. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

ENGINEERED STRUCTURES, INC. (ESI) – MARTIN LUTHER KING JR WAY.

From July 30 to August 20, 2024, ESI will bore power communication lines from ISU campus to Eli Oboler Library. There will be intermittent lane closure on Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

POCATELLO FOOD TRUCK ROUND-UP

The event runs from 2-10 PM, with road closures in the 100 block of S Garfield Ave. Motorists please be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

ISU MARCH THROUGH THE ARCH

The Idaho State University President's Office will be holding a procession of students on foot on Friday, August 16, 2024, from 5:45 - 6:15 PM. The procession is expected to have approximately 900 students on foot, including a marching band, but not vehicles. It will begin near the Reed Gym Building near the Holt Arena and conclude at the Quadrangle-Hutchinson Memorial. There will be temporary road closures on S. 8th Ave. and E. Carter St. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

WELCOME BACK BENGALS

Historic Downtown Pocatello is hosting "Welcome Back Bengals" on August 17, 2024, from 1-11 PM. The event is located at the 200 and part of the 300 block of E. Center Street. This area will be closed during the above-referenced times. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
