➔ **STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

FOG SEALING

The Street Operations crew will be fog sealing the streets as listed below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 5 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) ***The schedule may change due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or equipment breakdowns.*** Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be actively patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City, the work may result in possible lane closures and delays. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution.

PAVEMENT MARKING

Traffic Operations Department crew is repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings throughout the City, starting near schools. Intermittent lane closures will be in effect. Drivers should follow traffic control signs, avoid fresh paint, and expect delays during this painting season.

➔ **WATER DEPARTMENT**

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – WINGATE DR., TURACO AVE., FLAMINGO PL. AND FLAMINGO DR.

Starting July 1, 2024, the Water Department will replace water mainlines on Wingate Dr., Turaco Ave., Flamingo Pl., and Flamingo Dr. Work hours are 6:30 AM – 5 PM, Monday to Thursday. Street closures and restricted parking will be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution.

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. beginning August 10, 2022, until Fall 2024 for construction related to the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. CM COMPANY, INC. – N 6TH AVE.

From July 29 to November 30, 2024, CM Company, Inc. will be working on the construction of roadway and sidewalk improvement on N 6th Ave. There will be road closures between E. Clark St and E. Center. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

D-CO CONCRETE – N 5TH AVE.

From August 26 to September 23, 2024, ADA ramps will be installed on N. 5th Ave. between E Hayden St. and E. Wyeth St., leading to intermittent lane closures. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

ENGINEERED STRUCTURES, INC. (ESI) – MARTIN LUTHER KING JR WAY.

From July 30 to October 31, 2024, ESI will bore power communication lines from the ISU campus to Eli Oboler Library. There will be intermittent lane closure on Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

NEIGHBORHOOD BLOCK PARTY

A block party will be held on Saturday, September 14, 2024, on Fruitwood Lane between Indian Tree Lane and Old Ranch Road. This section of road will be closed from 4:30 – 9 PM during the event. Motorists should be cautious and expect delays in the area.

IDAHO STATE UNIVERSITY HOMECOMING PARADE

Idaho State University will be having their annual "Homecoming Parade" on Saturday, September 21, 2024. The parade will take place from 10:00 AM to NOON. The parade will start at the corner of S. 1st Ave. and E. Center St. and run on Center St. to 15th Ave. and will turn onto Memorial Dr. and end at Reed Gym. Roads will be closed during this time. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the area.

POCATELLO FOOD TRUCK ROUND-UP

Historic Downtown Pocatello is hosting a "Food Truck Round-Up" every Monday from 2 - 9 PM starting April 8 to September 23, 2024, at Lookout Point on S. Garfield Ave. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays as the area will be closed during these times.

PORTNEUF VALLEY FARMERS MARKET

The "Portneuf Valley Farmers Market" takes place every Saturday from May 4 to October 26, 2024, at Lookout Point in Historic Downtown Pocatello. The event is in the 100 block of S. Garfield Ave in front of the Marshall Public Library, causing road closures and potential delays.

BLOCK PARTY

A block party will be held on Sunday, September 22, 2024, from 10 AM – 2 PM at Caldwell Park. E. Lewis St. will be closed from S. 7th Ave. to S. 8th Ave. during the above-referenced times. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
