STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

FOG SEALING

The Street Department crew, in collaboration with a third-party company will be fog sealing the streets as listed below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 5 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may change due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or equipment breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be actively patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City, the work may result in possible lane closures and delays. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution.

PAVEMENT MARKING

Traffic Operations Department crew is repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings throughout the City, starting near schools. Intermittent lane closures will be in effect. Drivers should follow traffic control signs, avoid fresh paint, and expect delays during this painting season.

WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – WINGATE DR., TURACO AVE., FLAMINGO PL. AND FLAMINGO DR.

Starting July 1, 2024, the Water Department will replace water mainlines on Wingate Dr., Turaco Ave., Flamingo Pl., and Flamingo Dr. Work hours are 6:30 AM – 5 PM, Monday to Thursday. Street closures and restricted parking will be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution.

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. beginning August 10, 2022, until Fall 2024 for construction related to the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. CONTRACTORS

CM COMPANY, INC. – N 6TH AVE.

From July 29 to November 30, 2024, CM Company, Inc. will be working on the construction of roadway and sidewalk improvement on N 6th Ave. There will be road closures between E. Clark St and E. Center. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

D-CO CONCRETE – N 5TH AVE.

From August 26 to September 23, 2024, ADA ramps will be installed on N. 5th Ave. between E Hayden St. and E. Wyeth St., leading to intermittent lane closures. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

STARR CORPORATION

From September 16 to October 16, 2024, crew members will be installing sidewalks, curbs, gutters, bus stops, and landscaping on E. Humbolt St. from S. 5th Ave. to the corner near the Child Care—Early Learning Center at ISU, causing intermittent lane closures. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

ENGINEERED STRUCTURES, INC. (ESI) – MARTIN LUTHER KING JR WAY.

From July 30 to October 31, 2024, ESI will bore power communication lines from the ISU campus to Eli Oboler Library. There will be intermittent lane closure on Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

B&G PLUMBING – TAFT AVE.

From September 19 to September 27, 2024, crew members will be working on new construction of a sewer tap on 300 Taft Ave. leading to road closures. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

POCATELLO FOOD TRUCK ROUND-UP
