STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be actively patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City, the work may result in possible lane closures and delays. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution.

PAVEMENT MARKING

The Traffic Operations Department crew is repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings throughout the City, starting near schools. Intermittent lane closures will be in effect. Drivers should follow traffic control signs, avoid fresh paint, and expect delays during this painting season.

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Starting October 14, 2024, for approximately two weeks or until the project is completed, WPC will replace a manhole on the 1200 block of E. Clark St. between N. 11th & N. 12th Ave. JAG Enterprises will perform the work and will require bypassing the sanitary sewer mainline during the project. This may impact E. Center St. and E. Lander St. as well. Parking will be restricted in the construction zone. Motorists are advised to expect delays as traffic will be limited to one lane or possibly detoured during the project completion.

Additionally, WPC crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. beginning August 10, 2022, until Fall 2024 for construction related to the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. I-15 NORTHBOUND ENTRANCE RAMP - POCATELLO CREEK

On Tuesday, October 29, 2024, the System Interchange project will need to close the Pocatello Creek entrance ramp to Northbound I-15 for construction activities. Another closure of this ramp will be needed from Monday, November 4 to Thursday, November 7, 2024 for roadwork and paving projects. A detour route will be in place for these road closures. IDAHO STATE UNIVERSITY

BARTZ DR.

Starting October 14, through November 8, 2024, ISU will be repaving Bartz Dr., from the Schubert Heights at 1477 Bartz Dr. to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saint Building at 1701 Bartz Dr. Street closures and restricted parking will be implemented during construction. Please be advised to use caution in the area.

CONTRACTORS

CM COMPANY, INC. - N 6TH AVE.

From July 29 to November 30, 2024, CM Company, Inc. will be working on the construction of roadway and sidewalk improvement on N 6th Ave. There will be road closures between E. Clark St and E. Center. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

ENGINEERED STRUCTURES, INC. (ESI) - MARTIN LUTHER KING JR WAY.

From July 30 to October 31, 2024, ESI will bore power communication lines from the ISU campus to Eli Oboler Library. There will be intermittent lane closure on Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

JAG ENTERPRISES - E. CLARK ST.

From October 13 to October 28, 2024, crew members will be working on a sewer emergency on E. Clark St. There will be intermittent lane closures on E. Clark St. between N. 11th Ave. and N. 13th Ave. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

VOLTAGE POWER SOLUTIONS – W. BENTON ST.

From November 1, 2024, through March 1, 2025, crew members will be working on shoulder of 545 W. Benton St. to relocate Idaho Power Street Light Poles. There will be intermittent lane closures. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
