➔ STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be actively patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City, the work may result in possible lane closures and delays. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution.

RAISING MANHOLES AND WATER VALVES

Starting on Tuesday, November 5 to Friday, November 8, 2024, the Street Department along with the Water Department and WPC will be raising manholes and water valves on Pocatello Creek Rd. between Olympus Dr. and Booth Dr. There will be intermittent lane closures. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

PAVEMENT MARKING

The Traffic Operations Department crew is repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings throughout the City, starting near schools. Intermittent lane closures will be in effect. Drivers should follow traffic control signs, avoid fresh paint, and expect delays during this painting season.

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Starting October 14, 2024, for approximately two weeks or until the project is completed, WPC will replace a manhole on the 1200 block of E. Clark St. between N. 11th & N. 12th Ave. JAG Enterprises will perform the work and will require bypassing the sanitary sewer mainline during the project. This may impact E. Center St. and E. Lander St. as well. Parking will be restricted in the construction zone. Motorists are advised to expect delays as traffic will be limited to one lane or possibly detoured during the project completion.

Additionally, WPC crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work. Please be advised to use caution.

➔ IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. beginning August 10, 2022, until Fall 2024 for construction related to the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. I-15 NORTHBOUND ENTRANCE RAMP – POCATELLO CREEK RAMP

From Tuesday, November 5 to Friday, November 8, 2024, the System Interchange project will need to close the Pocatello Creek entrance ramp to Northbound I-15 for roadwork and paving projects. There will be a right lane closure for westbound traffic on Pocatello Creek Road from the Pocatello Creek exit to East of Syringa Street in addition to a right lane closure on Olympus Road for southbound traffic at the Pocatello Creek intersection. IDAHO STATE UNIVERSITY

BARTZ DR.

Starting October 14, through November 8, 2024, ISU will be repaving Bartz Dr., from Schubert Heights at 1477 Bartz Dr. to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saint Building at 1701 Bartz Dr. Street closures and restricted parking will be implemented during construction. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

INTERMOUNTAIN GAS

NEW NATURAL GAS LINE INSTALLATION

Beginning Monday, November 4 through Saturday, November 9, 2024, Intermountain Gas will be installing a new natural gas service line to serve 3414 Pole Line Rd. There will be intermittent lane closures on the 3400 block of Pole Line Rd. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

CONTRACTORS

CM COMPANY, INC. – N 6TH AVE.

From July 29 to November 30, 2024, CM Company, Inc. will be working on the construction of roadway and sidewalk improvement on N 6th Ave. There will be road closures between E. Clark St and E. Center. Please use adjacent roads for travel. Motorists should be cautious and anticipate delays in the area.

VOLTAGE POWER SOLUTIONS – W. BENTON ST.

From November 1, 2024, through March 1, 2025, crew members will be working on the shoulder of 545 W. Benton St. to relocate Idaho Power Street Light Poles. There will be intermittent lane closures. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

VETERANS DAY PARADE

There will be a Veterans Day Parade hosted on Saturday, November 9, 2024, from 11 AM – 1 PM. The parade will commence at S. 1st Ave. and Benton St. and head North until Center St. It will proceed East on Center St. until S. 10th Ave., then south on E. Lewis St. and head East to Caldwell Park where the parade will end. Motorists are advised to use caution in these areas.
