➞ **STREET SERVICES**

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is completed, crews will move to their regular sweeping schedule.

Regular sweeping schedule:

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

➞ **WATER DEPARTMENT**

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – TANAGER DR., HERON AVE. AND ORIOLE AVE.

Beginning Monday, March 10, 2025, for approximately 9 weeks, crews from the Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Tanager Dr., Heron Ave., and Oriole Ave. Work hours are between 6:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street may be closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Restricted parking will be in place during construction. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

➞ **WATER POLLUTION CONTROL**

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

POCATELLO CREEK (EXIT 71) SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

The System Interchange project will have night work occurring on the Pocatello Creek interchange (Exit 71) northbound entrance ramp from approximately 9 PM on April 8th to 6 AM on April 9th. This work will require a nighttime closure of the ramp, and detour signs will be in place to direct impacted traffic to the Clark Street interchange (Exit 69) during the closure.
