➔ STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is completed, crews will move to their regular sweeping schedule.

Regular sweeping schedule:

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

WATERLINE REPLACEMENT – POLE LINE ROAD AND TANAGER DRIVE INTERSECTION

Starting Monday, May 19, 2025 from 7:00 AM to 10:00 AM and Tuesday, May 20, 2025 from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM crews from the Water Department will be replacing the waterline at the intersection of Pole Line Road and Tanager Drive. Motorists may experience delays and lane closures during the above-referenced dates and times.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – TANGER DR., HERON AVE., AND ORIOLE AVE.

Continuing work that started Monday April 10, 2025, for approximately 9 weeks, crews from the Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Tanager Dr., Heron Ave., and Oriole Ave. Work hours are between 6:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday - Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street may be closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Restricted parking will be in place during construction. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

➔ WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will continue jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

NORTHBOUND 1-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

System Interchange project plans to have night work occurring next week to shift Northbound I-15 traffic to its final configuration.

POCATELLO CREEK INTERCHANGE EXIT 71

Closures starting Tuesday, May 20, 2025 through Friday, May 23, 2025 from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM. Work will require nighttime closures during the above-reference dates and times of the Pocatello Creek interchange (EXIT 71) Northbound entrance ramp and the I-86 Eastbound to I-15 Northbound interchange ramp. Detour signs will be in place to direct impacted traffic to the Clark Street interchange (EXIT 69) during the ramp closures. These events will be posted on the Idaho 511 website ([idaho 511](https://idaho511.com)). This work is weather dependent with the possibility of getting rescheduled.
