➔ **STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT**

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is completed, crews will move to their regular sweeping schedule.

Regular sweeping schedule:

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

➔ **WATER DEPARTMENT**

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – TANGER DR., HERON AVE., AND ORIOLE AVE.

Continuing work that started Monday April 10, 2025, for approximately 9 weeks, crews from the Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Tanager Dr., Heron Ave., and Oriole Ave. Work hours are between 6:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday - Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street may be closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Restricted parking will be in place during construction. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

➔ **WATER POLLUTION CONTROL**

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will continue jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

➔ **IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

STORM SEWER REPAIRS – E. ALAMEDA BETWEEN YELLOWSTONE AVE. & WARREN DR.

Wednesday, May 28, 2025, ITD is going to be completing storm sewer repairs. The 2 inner lanes on E. Alameda Rd. will be closed between Yellowstone Ave. and Warren Dr. for work to be done in the center of the roadway. Motorists are advised to use caution, watch for construction workers, and expect delays.

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Road construction continues for the System Interchange for I-86 and I-15 with crews working in multiple areas. Motorist should carefully follow posted construction signs and posted speed limits. This event is posted on the Idaho 511 website ([Idaho 511](#)).

To accommodate this event, area will be closed during 6:00 AM to 3:00 PM. This allows vendors time to set up and pack up safely. The event is scheduled between 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Motorists are advised to use caution, watch for pedestrians, and expect delays in the area during these hours.

Mondays, May 2025 - September 22, 2025 event time is 2:00 PM to 9:00 PM “Pocatello Food Truck Round Up” hosted by Historic Downtown Pocatello at Lookout Point (corner of W. Center St. and S.
