SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is completed, crews will move to their regular sweeping schedule.

- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Monday, June 2, 2025 to June, 30 2025 road construction continues on East Chubbuck Road both directions to construct the south half of the new roadway and to repave the roadway. This closure extends from Pleasant View Road to Fairgrounds Road, and traffic will be detoured to New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway. Chubbuck Road is planned to be reopened before the 4th of July.
