## **STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT**

#### **SWEEPING**

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is completed, crews will move to their regular sweeping schedule.

Wednesday: Fairway

#### **PATCHING**

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

### **PAVEMENT MARKINGS**

Beginning Monday, June 16, 2025, the Traffic Operations crew will begin repainting crosswalks throughout the City, weather permitting. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

### **PAVING - E. GRIFFITH ROAD**

Beginning Monday, June 16, 2025 to Wednesday, June 18, 2025, the Street Services crew will be paving E. Griffith Road from Yellowstone Avenue to Hiline Road. The street will be closed while work is being performed. Motorists are advised to consider alternate routes. Please use caution and expect delays in this area.

### I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Monday, June 2, 2025 to June 30, 2025 road construction continues on East Chubbuck Road both directions to construct the south half of the new roadway and to repave the roadway. This closure extends from Pleasant View Road to Fairgrounds Road, and traffic will be detoured to New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway.
