➔ STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Traffic Services crews are repainting crosswalks throughout the City, weather permitting. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – SOUTH ARTHUR AVENUE

Starting June 26, 2025, the Water Department will be replacing the water mainlines on S. Arthur Ave. between W. Whitman St. and S. Main St. Crews will work between 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Expect street closures and restricted parking to be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews continue jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorist may experience delays or lane closures while work is being performed.

RAISING MANHOLES – POCATELLO CREEK ROAD BETWEEN BENCH ROAD AND IRIS STREET

Crews will begin raising manholes along Pocatello Creek Rd. between Bench Rd. and Iris St. Expect lane closures and restricted driving to be in place.

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Work continues June 30, 2025, crews will be performing chip seal work to preserve the newly constructed roadways. This work will require various lane closures on I-15, I-86, and the interchange ramps. Striping crews will also be working to repaint roadway lane lines. The travelling public is advised to slow down, watch for construction crews, and drive cautiously while this work is being performed.
