SWEEPING

MICRO SEAL

Valley Slurry Seal will begin micro sealing the streets listed in the schedule below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 7 AM – 6 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

FOG SEALING

The Street Services crew will be fog sealing the streets as listed below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 7 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – SOUTH ARTHUR AVENUE

Ongoing construction continues from June 26, 2025, the Water Department will be replacing the water mainlines on S. Arthur Ave. between W. Whitman St. and S. Main St. Crews will work between 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Expect street closures and restricted parking to be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews continue jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorist may experience delays or lane closures while work is being performed.

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Ongoing construction continues from June 30, 2025, crews will be performing chip seal work to preserve the newly constructed roadways. This work will require various lane closures on I-15, I-86, and the interchange ramps. Striping crews will also be working to repaint roadway lane lines. The travelling public is advised to slow down, watch for construction crews, and drive cautiously while this work is being performed. JAG ENTERPRISES: 78 TRAIL CREEK RD

Ongoing construction continues from Monday, July 21, 2025 through Thursday, July 31, 2025, Trail Creek Rd. will be closed for sewer line repairs. The contractor will be excavating across Trail Creek Rd. Foothill Blvd. traffic will be detoured to Greenwood Ave. Riverside Dr. traffic will be detoured to Hawthorne Ave. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this improvement project. Please slow down and use caution when traveling in this area. Consider alternate routes or plan accordingly to allow extra travel time.

A PLUS CONTRACTORS: 2300 EAST TERRY ST.

From Monday, July 28, 2025, through Friday, August 1, 2025, East Terry Street will be reduced to one lane for sewer line work between 2302 East Terry Street and 2450 East Terry Street, near LA Semiconductor. Traffic will be managed by flaggers, and delays are expected as crews complete sewer line connections for a new subdivision. Drivers are advised to use caution in the area and consider alternate routes to avoid delays.

PLATINUM PLUMBING LLC: 169 VALLEYVIEW DR.

Tuesday, July 29, 2025 through Wednesday, July 30, 2025, Valleyview Dr. will be closed between Highland Blvd. and Westello Dr. for lateral sewer line replacement. During this time, traffic on **Valleyview Dr.** will be detoured from Westello Blvd. to Toponce Dr. Traffic approaching from **Highland Blvd.** will be detoured at Toponce Dr. to Westello Blvd. Please slow down and use caution when traveling through the area. Consider alternate routes or plan accordingly to allow extra travel time.

IDAHO POWER COMPANY: E. POPLAR ST BETWEEN JEFFERSON AVE. & FILMORE AVE.

Wednesday, July 30, 2025, an Idaho Power crew will be setting power poles on both the north and south sides of East Poplar St. between Jefferson Ave. and Filmore Ave. Motorists should expect traffic delays, flaggers, lane closures, and a possible detour while crews install power poles, crossarms, and conductors. Please slow down and use caution when traveling through the area. Consider using alternate routes or plan for additional travel time.
