➔ STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

MILLING AND PAVING

The Street Services crew will be milling and paving the streets listed in the schedule below. There will be intermittent lane closures while work is being performed, with restricted access to residents. No parking will be allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 7 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

- Hyde Ave. (E. Oak St. to Chase St.)

Wednesday August 6th, to Thursday, August 7th

- E. Humbolt St. (S. 5th Ave. to Cesar Chavez Ave.)

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Traffic Services crews are repainting crosswalks throughout the City, weather permitting. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – S. ARTHUR AVENUE

Ongoing construction continues from June 26, 2025, the Water Department will be replacing the water mainlines on S. Arthur Ave. between W. Whitman St. and S. Main St. Crews will work between 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Expect street closures and restricted parking to be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews continue jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorist may experience delays or lane closures while work is being performed.

➔ IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Ongoing construction continues into late August as crews will be performing chip seal work, roadway striping, and remaining work items. This work will require various lane closures on I-15, I-86, and the interchange ramps. The travelling public is advised to slow down, watch for construction crews, and drive cautiously while this work is being performed.

➔ CONTRACTORS

LA SEMICONDUCTOR - 2300 WEST BUCKSKIN/EAST TERRY STREET:

Friday, August 8, 2025, 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM, 2300 West Buckskin/East Terry Street will have lane closures for inspection work around manholes. Crews will be diverting traffic around manholes to perform necessary inspections. Lane shifts will be in place and managed with appropriate signage. Drivers should expect vehicle delays in the area. We recommend using alternate routes and advise all motorists to proceed with caution through the work zone.

MORRIS EXCAVATION - S. 2ND AVE AT FREDREGILL RD:

Tuesday, August 5, 2025 to Saturday, August 9, 2025, a section of S. 2nd Ave. will be closed near Fredregill Rd. for water and sewer repairs. Southbound traffic on S. 2nd Ave. will be detoured at Stansbury St. to S. 4th Ave. Northbound traffic on S. 2nd Ave. will be detoured at Fredregill Rd. to S. 5th Ave. The contractor will have appropriate signage in place, and all affected residences were notified one week prior to the start date of construction. Drivers should expect vehicle delays in the area. We recommend using alternate routes and advise all motorists to proceed with caution through the work zone.
