➔ **STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT**

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

MILLING AND PAVING

The Street Services crew will be milling and paving the streets listed in the schedule below. There will be intermittent lane closures while work is being performed, with restricted access to residents. No parking will be allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 7 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Traffic Services crews are repainting crosswalks throughout the City, weather permitting. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – S. ARTHUR AVENUE

Ongoing construction continues from June 26, 2025. The Water Department will be replacing the water mainlines on S. Arthur Ave. between W. Whitman St. and S. Main St. Crews will work between 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Expect street closures and restricted parking to be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access, and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

On Friday, August 8, 2025, WPC crews began raising the manhole located in front of the Subway at 1544 Pocatello Creek Road and are expected to complete the project on Monday, August 11, 2025. The work involves lane closures on Pocatello Creek Road and Olympus Road, with eastbound traffic reduced to one lane. Drivers are asked to use caution and expect delays when traveling in this area.

➔ IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE COMPLEX PROJECT

Ongoing construction continues into late August as crews will be performing chip seal work, roadway striping, and remaining work items. This work will require various lane closures on I-15, I-86, and the interchange ramps. The travelling public is advised to slow down, watch for construction crews, and drive cautiously while this work is being performed.

CANTILEVER SIGN REPLACEMENT

ITD will be replacing the Cantilever sign on E. Alameda Rd. between Warren Dr. and Yellowstone Ave. Work is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, August 13th, 2025, with the installation of the new foundation. No impact on traffic is anticipated until the old sign is removed and the new one is set. The travelling public is advised to slow down, watch for construction crews, and drive cautiously while this work is being performed.

DIRECT COMMUNICATIONS – W. CENTER ST. & W CLARK ST. ALLEY

Beginning Friday, August 15, 2025, Direct Communications crew will be micro-trenching in the alleyway between W. Center St. and W. Clark St. for fiber optic installation. Work will continue through the weekend and is expected to be completed on Wednesday, August 20, 2025. Please use caution and watch for the construction crew.
