➔ STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

MILLING AND PAVING

The Street Services crew will be milling and paving the streets listed in the schedule below. There will be intermittent lane closures while work is being performed, with restricted access to residents. No parking will be allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 7 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Traffic Services crews are repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings throughout the City, weather permitting. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – S. ARTHUR AVENUE

Ongoing construction continues from June 26, 2025, the Water Department will be replacing the water mainlines on S. Arthur Ave. between W. Whitman St. and S. Main St. Crews will work between 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Expect street closures and restricted parking to be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews continue jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the City. Motorist may experience delays or lane closures while work is being performed.

CANTILEVER SIGN REPLACEMENT–E. ALAMEDA RD. (WARREN DR. AND YELLOWSTONE AVE.):

ITD is continuing work to replace the Cantilever sign on E. Alameda Rd. between Warren Dr. and Yellowstone Ave. Work is scheduled to resume Monday, August 25th, 2025, with the installation of the new foundation. No impact on traffic is anticipated until the old sign is removed and the new one is set. The travelling public is advised to slow down, watch for construction crews, and drive cautiously while this work is being performed.

This area will be closed from 6:00 AM - 3:00 PM for event setup and takedown. Event scheduled time is 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Expect increased pedestrian traffic and vehicle delays in this area. Please use caution and consider alternate routes.

RESIDENTIAL BLOCK PARTY– W. FREMONT ST. (N. JOHNSON AVE AND N. GRANT AVE):

Saturday, September 6, 2025, a residential block party will be held on Fruitwood Lane between Indian Tree Lane & Old Ranch Road. This area will be closed from 4:00 PM to 10:00 PM to ensure the safety of participants during setup, the scheduled event, and takedown.
