STREET SERVICES DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

PATCHING

The Street Services crew will be actively patching potholes and curb lines throughout the City; the work may result in intermittent lane closures and delays. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Traffic Operations crews are repainting crosswalks, arrows, and lane markings throughout the City, weather permitting. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – S. ARTHUR AVENUE

Ongoing construction continues from June 26, 2025. The Water Department will be replacing the water mainlines on S. Arthur Ave. between W. Whitman St. and S. Main St. Crews will work between 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday to Thursday. Expect street closures and restricted parking to be in place during construction. Efforts will be made to provide local access, and access to properties will be restored daily. Please be advised to use caution and expect delays while work is being performed.

EVENTS FOR THIS WEEK

PORTNEUF VALLEY FARMERS MARKET

HALLOWEEN BLOCK PARTY

Saturday, October 25, 2025, E. Elm St. will be closed between Jefferson Ave. and Randolph Ave. for a Music Festival with local vendors, games, and food trucks. This area will be closed from 2:00 PM to 9:30 PM for the street music festival. Expect increased pedestrian traffic and vehicle delays in this area. Please use caution and use alternate routes.

IDAHO STATE UNIVERSITY HOMECOMING PARADE

Idaho State University will host its annual Homecoming Parade on Saturday, October 25, 2025. The parade will start at 1st Avenue and Center Street, travel east on Center Street, and end at 15th Avenue/Memorial Drive and MLK Jr. Way. It will run from 10:00 a.m. to approximately noon. Roads will be closed during this time. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the area.
