911 Call to Dispatch Transcribed, April 5 at 5:00 p.m.

DISPATCHER: 911, what's the address of your emergency?

CALLER: Hi, yeah, I work at a shop it's at 658 North Main and there is a couple out back behind their shop brandishing a knife. Looks like they're trying to stab someone. There's a man and a woman and then another guy in the street, uh who seems like he's antagonizing him. One guys got a knife and looks like he's under the influence and they're out in their back yard chasing each other around.

DISPATCHER: Okay. And they're in the back yard of a residence?

CALLER: Yeah, back yard of the residence. Um, I don't know the exact address. I'm at 658 North Main and...

DISPATCHER: Okay.

CALLER: Uh, I got a little bit of video of it, but this guy he seems pretty drunk. He's just keeps running at em with a knife and then falling over and then I think he just stabbed himself on accident just now.

DISPATCHER: Okay. Can I keep you on the phone for just a second?

CALLER: Yeah, of course.

DISPATCHER: Okay. So, it's just the three of them and then the just the one with the knife?

CALLER: Yeah, one guy with a knife. There's a guy hittin him with a stick from the alleyway, and then the wife who's just trying to calm the guy down. It looks like he just sat on the ground and sorta passed out.

DISPATCHER: Okay.

- TYPING

CALLER: Um, looks like the other guy in the alleys approaching him now and the guys standing up with the knife again.

DISPATCHER: Okay.

CALLER: He got popped in the head with a...

DISPATCHER: What is your name, hun?

CALLER: Uh, my name is [REDACTED].

DISPATCHER: Okay. When you say they're in the back yard, which are they which way is the yard from where you're at?

CALLER: So, uh, if he's coming from uh Main Street, uh, it's behind A Plus Auto Repair. You hit a right on Main Street from Main Street and there is this side road here on Bridger.

DISPATCHER: Okay. It's behind the auto repair shop?

CALLER: Yep, behind the auto repair shop. Behind uh, A One Auto or A Plus Auto Repair.

DISPATCHER: Okay. A Plus okay.

CALLER: Things are starting to get escalated again.

DISPATCHER: Okay. I'll just keep you on the phone. I have officers responding, but just let me know what you're seeing, okay?

CALLER: Okay, sounds good.

DISPATCHER: Does it look like...

CALLER: Looks like the girl's trying to calm him down.

DISPATCHER: Does it look like he's injured at all?

CALLER: Ummm, he's laying on the ground sorta, he looks like he's on drugs or something. He's kinda tweaking out of his mind just rolling around and, but uh, he keeps he just keeps pulling the knife at them and yellin something. They're they're not speaking English.

DISPATCHER: They're not speaking English?

CALLER: Yeah.

DISPATCHER: Okay.

CALLER: Yeah that guy's gotta be on hard drugs for sure.

DISPATCHER: Okay.

CALLER: I have my dad recording the whole thing right now as well.

DISPATCHER: Okay, cool.

- TYPING

CALLER: Yeah, he might be having a seizure or something. He just keeps sorta shaking and floppin around on the ground.

MALE IN BACKGROUND: He got hit on the head.

CALLER: Oh, he got hit on the head with a, oh wait, my dad's saying he got hit on the head with a log.

- UNINTELLIGIBLE SPEAKING IN THE BACKGROUND

CALLER: Yeah.

DISPATCHER: So, the other male hit him in the head with a log?

CALLER: That's what it sounds, that's what my dad's saying here.

DISPATCHER: Okay. Can you see if he's, is he on the ground now?



CALLER: Yeah, he keeps trying to stand up and the girl keeps pushing him down on the ground.

MALE IN BACKGROUND: He tried to stab her.

CALLER: Yeah, he keeps trying to stab everybody it looks like.

DISPATCHER: Okay.

CALLER: It's a big knife, like, it's fuckin that's a huge knife now.

DISPATCHER: Okay. So, it's like more of a, like a hunting knife, or is it like a machete type knife?

CALLER: umm, it looks like a really big kitchen knife.

DISPATCHER: For the kitchen, okay.

CALLER: And then, there, the neighbors seem to be uhhh crowding around so now there's more people involved.

DISPATCHER: Okay. Alright, we're we'll stage EMS as well just in case, but.

CALLER: Yeah, no but looks like nobody too hurt except the guy with the knife.

DISPATCHER: Yeah, he got hit with a log, he's probably gonna have a little bit of a headache.

- UNINTELLIGIBLE SPEAKING IN THE BACKGROUND

DISPATCHER: So, they're behind the 702, right? In that like brown house?

CALLER: Uhh, it's a white house.

DISPATCHER: A white house, okay.

CALLER: There's a red truck and a red Jeep in the back yard.

DISPATCHER: You said a red truck and a black Jeep? Is that what you said?

CALLER: Red truck, red Jeep.

DISPATCHER: Red Jeep.

CALLER: And there's a blue car parked on the street next to it.

CALLER: Cool, I can hear the sirens.

- TYPING

- SIRENS APPROACHING IN BACKGROUND

CALLER: Yeah, they seem to be arguing now.

DISPATCHER: Okay.

MALE IN BACKGROUND: This is like a (unintelligible) domestic.

CALLER: Definitely domestic, for sure.

MALE IN BACKGROUND: Yeah (unintelligible)

DISPATCHER: Okay.



MALE IN BACKGROUND: Grandad and grandson.

CALLER: Yeah, I see the officer here.

DISPATCHER: Okay. Ya'll just wanna make sure that it looks like they're finding the right people.

CALLER: Oh, yep, they're here.

DISPATCHER: Okay, I'll let you go then, okay? Just stay there at the business, alright?

CALLER: Yep.

DISPATCHER: Alright, thank you. mmmbye.

CALLER: Yep, they're all there. K.
