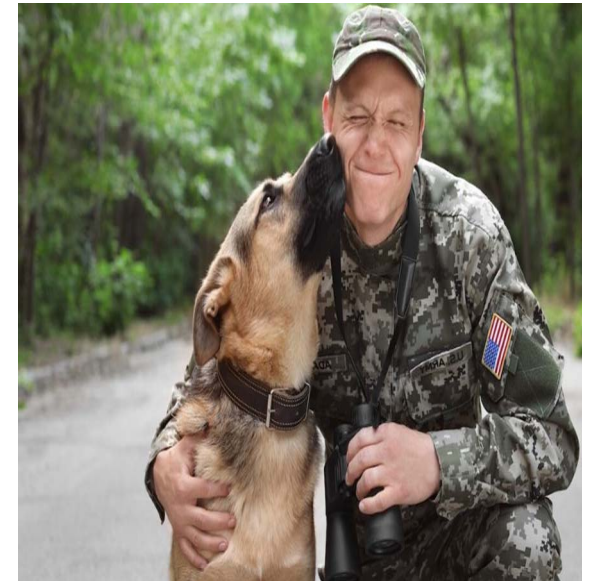

A WAY TO SAY “THANKS”

Time and again ordinary people have stood up and served our Nation in extraordinary ways, so that all Americans can pursue the “American Dream” of life, love, and the pursuit of happiness that our Founding Fathers envisioned. With their service they have continued to make America strong and protected our way of life.

Animals also play an important role in our daily lives. They supply us with unconditional love, support, loyalty, and protection which only an animal can provide. Our goal is to provide that for our Veterans and Armed Service Members through the adoption of one of our homeless animals

Who Qualifies??

Any Active Duty Armed Service Member or Veteran

In order to qualify, the member must provide identification to show proof of service. Identification accepted includes:

- DD214 or equivalent paperwork
- VA Health Benefits Card
- Military Identification Card
- State Issued ID with Veteran Status
- Dependent Identification or Spouse Card

(families with children under 18 years are eligible)

What does the program pay for?

The program pays a portion of the regular adoption fee at the Pocatello Animal Shelter (based upon available funding). Call the Shelter for current adoption rates.

What does the adoption fee cover?

Our adoption fee covers:

- Spay/Neuter Surgery
- Rabies Vaccination
- Current Distemper/Parvo and Dewormer Vaccinations
- City License (if within the City of Pocatello)
- Microchip
- Collar
- Food Sample

My landlord wants my pet to be certified for housing. Can this program help?

Your landlord has valid concerns about allowing you to have a pet in your home. Our adoption program includes most of the vaccinations required and licenses your pet with the City of Pocatello. Talk to the shelter staff for more information.
