GUIDELINES FOR DOG PARK USE

As Recommended by Bannock Bark Parks, Inc.

- 1. Owners/custodians may be legally and financially responsible for any injuries, damages or loss caused by their dog.
- 2. Do not bring puppies under four months of age or female dogs in heat to the dog park for their own safety and health.
- 3. Be prepared to leash your dog and/or remove your dog from the dog park if it becomes unruly.
- 4. Honor the requests of other dog park users to leash your dog.
- 5. Limit your use of the dog park to three dogs per owner/custodian per visit.
- 6. Dogs are the only animals allowed in the dog park.
- 7. Keep the dog park area clean and free of trash.
- 8. Do not bring tobacco, food (dog or human), or glass containers into the dog park for safety reasons.
- 9. Use dog toys and training equipment sparingly to prevent dog fights.
- 10. Supervise children who accompany you to the dog park for the safety of both the children and dogs. Encourage calm behavior by children in the presence of dogs.
- 11. Keep vaccinations, including rabies, parvo virus, distemper and Bordetella (for kennel cough) current for your dog.
- 12. Spiked or pronged dog collars are not recommended as they may cause injury to other dogs or humans.
- 13. Educate yourself on dog behavior and be aware that dogs have different play styles.
